

1. SUMMARY OF OVERALL JOB ASSIGNMENT

The Shift Supervisor will manage allocated shift resources so as to meet the specified Production Program whilst maintaining all statutory requirements and meeting the specified efficiency, safety and quality criteria.

- The Shift Supervisor oversees the day-to-day operation of each shift in the Production Department of the manufacturing facility, ensuring that the budgeted capacity is met or exceeded.
- The Shift Supervisor is a key player in the areas of Safety, Environment, Quality and Process improvement.

3. MAIN ACTIVITIES / RESPONSIBILITIES

Responsibilities

- Manage Shop Floor Control (SFC), SFC-QP (quality version) and SAP.
- Log accidents/injury details, quality non-conformance, CTE issues and other required records.
- Manage the daily operation of the plant as required to meet scheduled requirements, via the operators.
- Timely troubleshooting and correction of plant and product faults with the assistance of the engineering department and site management team.
- Ensure the Quality of Products produced meet the Knauf Plasterboard product specifications.
- Optimisation of processes and equipment, including energy and raw materials consumption.
- Checking and authorisation of time sheets and pay records.
- Log accidents/injury details, quality non-conformance, CTE issues and other required records.
- Operation of the plant as required to meet scheduled requirements, via the operators
- Timely troubleshooting and correction of plant and product faults with the assistance of the Plant Manager, Production Manager, Engineering Manager and Maintenance Supervisor, as required.
- Maintenance of Safe Working Practices and good Housekeeping Practices on the shift
- Checking and authorisation of time sheets and pay records.
- Reporting on shift performance, including variances from production standards through Shop Floor Control (SFC) and SFC-QP (quality version).
- Control of absenteeism.
- Selection, induction and general training of replacement shift personnel to meet the full requirements of their shift role.
- Preparation and updating of Performance Plans as instructed by the Plant or Production Managers.
- Active implementation of Knauf's occupational health and safety policy, in all manufacturing areas.
- Ensure the Quality of Products produced meet the Knauf Plasterboard product specifications.
- Active implementation of KPB's environmental management policy.
- Achievement of the plants budgeted performance efficiencies as a minimum requirement.
- Effective representation of KPB's first line industrial relations and policy communication to all production personnel.
- Acts in accordance with Knauf policy and procedures and strictly within limits of Authority.
- Active implementation of the Knauf occupational health and safety policy.
- Commitment to the Knauf Code of Conduct.
- Other duties and activities as assigned from time to time.



5. MINIMUM COMPETENCIES REQUIRED FOR THE JOB

Professional and/or technical competencies:

- Able to lead, motivate, assist and direct the activities of a team.
- Familiar with a variety of management skills to improve individual and team performance.
- · Good planning and organisational skills.
- Written and verbal communication expertise and effective delegation ability.
- · High levels of attention to detail and accuracy.
- Able to achieve results in an environment that has tight deadlines.
- Understanding of benchmarking and then implementing change to achieve best practice.

Behavioural and/or managerial competencies:

- Leads by example and show initiative.
- Positive and enthusiastic with a genuine 'can do' mentality.
- A personal customer focussed mentality and an ability to get others committed to serving customers (including Internal Customers).
- Stays calm under pressure when handling multiple tasks decisive.
- If necessary, able to handle tough, confrontational situations and drive through change.
- Open attitude to learning and positive criticism.
- Shows initiative and is creative.
