Job Purpose:	Responsible for the Airco Information and Technology Systems and providing leadership and management for the IT Team. Also responsible for driving technology improvement through major projects including ERP (SAP B1) improvements, and Salesforce enhancements, together with the design, development, and deployment of information technology policy and strategies that will allow Airco to achieve its business strategies.

Main Duties

1. In partnership with the business users, lead and initiate business applications projects that can create increased business productivity and efficiency.
2. Provide leadership and management of the IT team, including deployment and implementation of goals, policies, procedures, and operations for all information technology solutions to support a culture of continuous improvement.
3. Perform business systems project management including detailed scoping of the requirements and costs, produce technical statements of work and liaise with consultants.
4. Manage all business application vendors (excludes CRM).
5. Lead from a technology perspective and have hands on role in the ideation, design, implementation and the support for organisation's business and technical systems e.g., ERP, CRM, WMS, B2B, Ecommerce, etc.
6. Participate in regular team planning, sprint and general discussion meetings including advising business users on business applications (ERP, WMS, etc) functional capability.
7. Using configurable and code-based tools, develop and deploy solutions with high-maintainability and durability for ERP, WMS, etc.
8. Responsible for development of code-based functionality for Salesforce when requested by Systems administrator.
9. Integrate ERP with external systems using APIs and file drops.
10. Maintain 99%+ uptime of system and ensure system integrity and security.
11. Responsible for building relations with customers EDI team including mapping, configuring, testing, rollout and support for EDI.
12. Maintain documentations for all business applications including Standard Operating Procedures.
13. Keep abreast of business applications technology and solutions to mitigate technology liability.
14. Support the design, development, and deployment of information technology policy and strategies that will allow Airco to achieve its business strategies.

15. Responsible for supporting business for IT infrastructure in absence of System Administrator.
16. Follow Company Quality, Safety and Environmental Procedures as outlined in the Company IMS Manual.
17. Continually analyse and update processes and procedures to ensure a culture of continuous improvement.
18. Promote safe working practices at all times.
19. Any other reasonable duties which may from time to time be requested by the management team.
