PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Operate and maintain items of plant and equipment as required in a safe and competent manner in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.
- Actively undertake physical labouring tasks as required.
- Implement traffic control plans and perform traffic control duties.
- Participate in community education and other engagement activities related to Environmental and Recreational matters.
- Ensure that work is performed to a high standard and completed in a timely manner.
- Complete and provide accurate documentation as required.
- Clean Council's public amenities including toilets, rubbish bins and litter as required.
- Perform and/or report maintenance and repairs required to Council facilities.
- Close and secure Council facilities as required.
- Actively participate in team development and meetings and promote improvement in Council procedures and assist Council to achieve its objectives.
- Hold and maintain Roads and Maritime Services RMS approved Traffic Controller, Apply Traffic Control Plans, and Prepare Workzone Traffic Management Plans qualifications as required.
- Hold and main current competency in chemical application accreditation to AQF Level 3 or above.
- Hold and maintain a current driver's licence.
- Undertake training as required.
- Comply with Council's Work Health and Safety (WHS) processes and actively participate in WHS consultation and training.
- Actively contribute to ensuring that a safe work environment and safe systems of work are in place.
- Participate in the development and implementation of Councils WHS policies, procedures and guidelines, and other documentation.
- Obtain and/or maintain currency of first aid qualifications as required.
- Provide assistance to others in the team as required.
- Perform other duties as required.
