TIER 1 SCHOLARSHIP - RURAL OPPORTUNITIES

Tier 1 Scholarships has been designed for our rural locations with the following incentives:



FINANCIAL - \$6500 + Location incentives*
(\$500 initial payment; \$3000 at end of 1st and 2nd year)



LOCATION BENEFITS - Subsidised Accommodation and Travel Expenses



EMPLOYMENT - Permanency on Appointment

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - TIER 1 SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible to receive a Tier 1 Scholarship, the applicant must:



Be due to graduate and confer in 2024 and be able to obtain provisional QCT Registration prior to the commencement of the 2025 School Year.



Accept a teaching position anywhere within Catholic Education - Diocese of Rockhampton. The eligible locations for the Tier 1 Scholarships are: LONGREACH, BARCALDINE, BLACKALL, CLERMONT, SPRINGSURE, EMERALD, MONTO and BILOELA

Tier 3 Scholarship has been designed for graduate teachers to offer certainty and permanency to assist in kick-starting your teaching career and offers the following incentives:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - TIER 3 SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible to receive a Tier 3 Scholarship, the applicant must:



Be due to graduate and confer in 2024 and be able to obtain provisional QCT Registration prior to the commencement of the 2025 School Year.



Eligible locations include ROCKHAMPTON, YEPPOON, GRACEMERE, MACKAY, SARINA, WALKERSTON, GLADSTONE and TANNUM SANDS.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS



Scholarships are available to high achieving pre-service teachers who demonstrate professional knowledge, practice and engagement, provide evidence of successfully passing the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education, support the Catholic ethos and mission and are eligible for employment as a graduate primary teacher to commence in 2025.



High achieving graduates will be identified on the basis of professional experience reports, application responses and referee statements.



HOW TO APPLY

All interested applicants are required to complete an application on the Careers Opportunity Page on the Catholic Education - Diocese of Rockhampton website (Select Graduate Teachers > Graduate Primary Teacher Scholarship Program).

Submit your application by <u>30 April 2024</u> and provide the following:

Resume
Cover Letter

Selection Criteria Response

Copies of 1st, 2nd and 3rd professional experience placement reports (available at time of application) and date of your final professional experience placement (if known)

Three nominated professional referees with at least one referee being a teaching mentor from a practicum

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be contacted within 15 business days of receipt of application by a member of the Scholarship Team. Applicants will be interviewed by a panel including Assistant Director: Schools.

Early offer of permanency for successful Scholarship applicants will occur in June 2024. Initial payment of \$500 will occur upon receipt of your acceptance.

Formal offers of employment including advice of school placement are provided in September 2024. The formal offer of employment process occurs after the Primary Staffing Conference has occurred in August 2024.
