What's the focus of this position?

This role is responsible for overseeing the day to day running of the Program Delivery team, which consists of 4 Program Managers. As the leader of the team, this role will provide direction, instruction and guidance to empower and facilitate achievement of recognised goals, programs outcomes and benefits. With a strategic asset management focus, it will ensure program directions are in continual alignment to ensure that benefits are delivered, and organisational goals and strategic objectives are met.





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What you'll be doing:

- Providing professional advice for the successful portfolio management and delivery of programs and program management services.
- Coordinating, monitoring and reporting on program of works for the delivery of infrastructure renewal and capital projects in following program streams; Stormwater and Environment, Roads and Transport, Priority Projects (City Centre and Coastal revitalisation) and Citywide initiatives.
- Fostering ownership and accountability, reconciling cross project and multi-disciplinary objectives and encouraging collaboration with all stakeholders including clients, Asset owners and teams within the Program & Project Services Service Element to identify priorities, effective service delivery and manage competing program priorities.
- Overseeing and managing program risks and opportunities, program financials, change governance and intended program benefits.
- Ensuring targets and processes are in place to facilitate an effective, transparent framework that ensures the successful delivery of asset management program streams.
- HR activities for the team including recruitment, training, performance management and annual performance development plans, with the assistance of People & Culture when necessary.
- Fostering and contributing to a team environment that creates a culture of safety, innovation and continuous improvement.
- You will be required to carry out other duties that are within the limits of your skills, competence, training and/or experience as directed by your Manager.

- Degree in Engineering with Project Management training or qualifications, or a combination
 of relevant training / experience in an asset or built environment to meet the requirements
 of the role.
- Substantial experience in the delivery performance monitoring and reporting, risk management, change management and quality governance of a program of works.
- Demonstrated experience and ability to lead, coach and support staff to achieve work targets and objectives, effectively and efficiently.
- High level written and verbal communication skills with demonstrated experience writing reports, developing and maintaining budgets, presenting and influencing outcomes.
- Advanced computer skills, with a demonstrated understanding of Program and Project management and estimating systems.
- Experience interpreting and applying legislation in relation to infrastructure.
- Experience delivering business improvements at the Portfolio, Program and Project level for the scoping, delivery, capacity planning and benefits management of programs and projects.





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Other valuable skills you may have:

- Experience developing capital works programs that provide a balance between servicing needs and financial constraints.
- Experience working within an Asset Management environment.
- Experience creating documentation and applying for Federal and State grants for major infrastructure projects.
- Proven experience coordinating and administering tender / contract documentation, for the on-ground delivery of major capital and renewal infrastructure projects.
