With 700+ people around the world, and projects in over 40 countries, our Strategy 2025 is all about impact – specifically, the impact of The George Institute's activities on the health of millions of people, particularly those living in disadvantaged circumstances around the world.

- Better Treatments: finding better treatments for the world's biggest health problems
- Better Care: transforming primary health care to support better health for more people
- Healthier Societies: harnessing the power of communities, governments, and markets to improve health

- Together with Aboriginal communities in NSW, Australia, we developed an innovative community led program to assist young Aboriginal drivers attain their license, now implemented in a dozen of locations
- We are developing an affordable dialysis machine, with potential to save millions of lives each year and transform the way kidney disease is treated globally

Duties and Key Responsibilities

- Manage a portfolio of 100 major donors and prospects by developing engagement strategies to deepen their involvement and grow their philanthropic support of The George
- Work strategically with researchers and other Development team members to develop compelling proposals that align with donors' interest
- Work to agreed annual performance targets and develop a clear plan to achieve these.
- Provide specialist expertise on major donor fundraising and solicitation techniques to researchers to develop long-term relationships with key major donors
- Build and manage relationships with key internal and external stakeholders across The George.
- Analyse and report on major donor trends and best practices, making recommendations for continuous improvement of program strategy and processes
- Work with the Development Director, Australia, in the development of ideas and strategies to maximise philanthropic revenue
- Contribute to developing internal processes and operational functions for The George to help maximise its philanthropic potential.
