### Key Accountabilities

- Undertake the role within the EN scope of practice, legislation and GEO Healthcare policy
- Maintain the standard of nursing practice within the GEO Healthcare location by practicing nursing within the scope of practice of an EN, qualifications and experience.
- Maintain current knowledge and clinical proficiency in nursing care, in accordance with best practice, legal and professional standards.
- Clinically assess patients within the scope of an EN and refers a patient to the RN, when clinically indicated.
- Assist the RN in the management of medical emergencies at the GEO Healthcare location.
- Undertake primary health care nursing clinics under the supervision of a RN.
- Undertake Integrated Care Plans under the supervision of a RN.
- Implement care and treatment as ordered by the MO, NP or specialist nursing staff.
- Administer medications to patients as prescribed and within GEO Healthcare policy and legislative requirements.
- Provide healthcare, which is compliant with infection control policies and procedures.
- Initiate and maintain compliance with standards for accreditation as well as contractual obligations.
- Assist in the implementation of care to meet patient needs.
- Perform specific observations of the patient and report any deviation from the normal parameters to the RN.
- Promptly report and document accidents, incidents and errors observed in the delivery of patient care.
- Documents all patient occasions of service in the electronic medical record (EMR) and maintains confidentiality of health records.
- Complies with the Centre's Risk Management Policy including reporting any person who is at-risk of self-harm.
- Participates in health promotion and educational programs.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as designated by the HSM.
- Ensure compliance with Company policies, procedures, the Governance, Risk and Compliance Manual and the Code of Conduct.

- Current registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) as an Enrolled Nurse.
- Demonstrated recent and substantial clinical nursing experience.
- Demonstrated ability to plan and coordinate patient care.
- Demonstrated competence in clinical and problem-solving skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work within multi-disciplinary team.
- Demonstrated ability to contribute to the professional practice within the health facility.
- Demonstrated competence in written and verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrates basic level of computer literacy.
- Clinical experience in a primary health care is desirable.
- Demonstrated knowledge of Equal Employment Opportunity and Workplace Health and Safety principles.

### Other Requirements Of the Role

- Valid and current full Australian driver's licence.
- Ability to work within a prison setting, which will involve direct contact with people in prison associated with the delivery of healthcare.
- Satisfactory completion of a National Criminal History Check.
- Ability to obtain and maintain a security clearance.
- Working outside of ordinary business hours may be required.
