Purpose of the Role

To provide optimal holistic personal care and support services to residents.

Operating Environment

This position is located in Toowoomba at Salem Lutheran Aged Care of Lutheran Community Care (LCC), a respected not-for-profit organisation providing services in the fields of aged care, family and youth support, disability and chaplaincy in South-East Queensland.

Salem Lutheran Aged Care

Salem is comprised of 3 residential aged care services at two separate locations in Toowoomba providing 97 low care places, 32 high care places, a 14 room dementia unit and 28 Home Care Packages.

Reporting Relationships

The Personal Carer reports to the Care Manager and receives direction from the Clinical Nurse, Registered and Enrolled Nurses.

Major Responsibilities

Within the policies established by LCC and working in collaboration with relevant managers and employees, the occupant of this position will:

- Provide direct care to residents in accordance with individual care plans;
- Collect data to assist with the formation of care plans and funding submissions;
- Document patient care accurately and objectively on iCare;
- Modify practice to accommodate individuality of residents and involve them and their families in the delivery of care.

Qualifications and Experience

The incumbent will possess a Certificate III (or higher) in Aged Care or equivalent. Previous experience in a residential aged care service is desirable. Maintenance of a Positive Federal Police check is essential.

The incumbent will be required to provide medical information relevant to this position by submitting to a pre-employment medical and be deemed fit by LCC Chief Medical Officer.
