### **Purpose of the Role**

This role is responsible for assisting in the provision of resident care as well as administering medications to residents.

### **Operating Environment**

This position is located in Buderim at the Immanuel Gardens service of Lutheran Services, a respected not-for-profit organisation providing services in the fields of aged care, disability, family support, youth support and chaplaincy in Queensland.

### **Immanuel Gardens**

Immanuel Gardens consists of 93 self-contained units, residential accommodation for 145 residents and provides 31 Home Care Packages within the local community.

### **Reporting Relationships**

The Enrolled Nurse reports to the Clinical Coordinator and works in consultation with Clinical Nurse Consultants and Registered Nurses.

Assistants in Nursing will report to the Enrolled Nurse in pursuit of maintaining resident care.

### **Major Responsibilities**

Within the policies established by Lutheran Services and working in collaboration with relevant managers and employees, the occupant of this position will:

- Administer medication (within scope of practice) to residents;
- Assist with direct resident care;
- Participate in the assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of resident support as directed and in conjunction with the Registered Nurse;
- Collect and report data and complete assessments to assist with the formation of nursing care plans and funding submissions for each resident;
- Establish and maintain collaborative relationships within the service and also members of the external health care team.

**Qualifications and Experience**

The incumbent will possess AHPRA (Enrolled Nurse) registration and a Diploma of Nursing (or equivalent). Previous experience in aged care is desirable as is a First Aid Certificate. Computer literacy as well as verbal and written communication skills are required.

Maintenance of an Australian Driver's Licence and Positive Federal Police check is essential.

The incumbent will be required to provide medical information relevant to this position by submitting to a pre-employment medical and be deemed fit by Lutheran Services Chief Medical Officer
