Purpose of the Role

To lead a team of nurses in the care of our residents to improve and maintain their quality of life, supporting good practice.

Operating Environment

This position is located in Kingaroy at the Orana Lutheran Aged Care of Lutheran Services, a respected not-for-profit organisation providing services in the fields of aged care, disability, family support, youth support and chaplaincy in Queensland.

Orana Lutheran Complex

Orana is the largest aged care complex in the South Burnett and has 94 care places, including a dementia wing, as well as 25 independent living units and a day therapy centre.

Reporting Relationships

The Registered Nurse reports to the Care Manager. Enrolled Nurses, Assistants in Nursing and Personal Carers will report to the Registered Nurse.

Major Responsibilities

Within the policies established by Lutheran Services and working in collaboration with relevant managers and employees, the occupant of this position will:

- Coordinate clinical staff in a designated area of the service during each shift;
- Maintain and promote the delivery of quality care of aged care residents according to the Aged Care Standards and good practice;
- Collect and report information and complete assessments to assist with the formation and review of nursing care plans and funding submissions for each resident;
- Undertake responsibility for own practice in accordance with relevant legislation;
- Establish and maintain collaborative relationships within the service and also members of the external health care team.

Qualifications and Experience

Incumbent must possess current AHPRA (Nursing) Registration as well as Bachelor of Nursing (or equivalent). Demonstrated experience within the aged care sector is desirable. Knowledge of current issues relating to the aged care industry and computer literacy are essential.

Incumbent must maintain a positive federal police check and Australian driver's licence.

The incumbent will be required to provide medical information relevant to this position by submitting to a pre-employment medical and be deemed fit by Lutheran Services Chief Medical Officer.
