6. Competence in setting priorities and programs to meet business planning objectives and statutory requirements;
7. Demonstrated skills and experience in the development and maintenance of effective stakeholder relationships, including Community Consultative Committees;
8. Current Class C Driver's License.

Desirable requirements

1. Post Graduate Qualifications in project management;
2. Experience and demonstrated commitment to Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) in the civil construction industry and awareness of relevant legislation;
