Context

City Enterprises is the Service Delivery unit of Palmerston North City Council. It is responsible for providing both professional services as well as physical works for internal and external clients.

The Technical Services Division provides a variety of professional services covering the disciplines of civil and structural engineering, public health engineering, roading, architecture, draughting, surveying, forestry and facilities management.

Main Purpose

To support the senior Roading Engineer in the management of the Palmerston North City Council Roading Maintenance Contract and the delivery of other roading physical works contracts.

To develop skills within roading infrastructure and other areas of Local Government and progress towards professional membership.

To provide technical advice, design, and project management for engineering works for the Palmerston North City Council.

Key Areas of Responsibility

Design Services

Planning, Investigation and Detailed design undertaken on nominated projects across a range of roading activities.

Contract and Project Management

Oversight and assistance with delivery of contracts and projects, including:

- Preparation of documentation for contracts
- Management of contracts
- Co-ordination of staff and resources
- Assistance with long-range works programming and actioning of works





Technical Advice

Advice on technical aspects of nominated projects across a range of roading areas, including identification of risks, options, and delivery.

Investigation and Research

Collation and analysis of data and information, and provision of innovative and effective advice.

Ongoing Professional Development

To actively progress toward achieving Chartered Professional Engineer (CPEng) status.

Maintaining the Business Approach

Ensure that services provided to Clients are undertaken in accordance with the relevant contractual agreements and are actioned in a timely, efficient and responsible manner.

Foster client relationships and maintain effective communication with all clients at all times. Contribute to the Business Plan objectives of City Enterprises in a proactive manner.
