The role will conduct quantitatve analysis of data and contribute to research and evaluation projects in general, through data collection, cleaning, storage, analysis, and report writing.

Core Responsibilities

- Under the direction of the senior research and evaluation officer, contribute to the implementation of program evaluations and research studies
- Conduct detailed quantitative analysis of research and evaluation data using Excel, SPSS, and other data analysis and survey building software
- Build and support positive relationships with key stakeholders within and external to RANSW
- Comply with Workplace Health and Safety in line with the organisation's Workplace Health and Safety Policy and procedures.

Key Tasks

- Collate and clean data before conducting statistical analysis (including descriptive analysis, correlation, regression and variance)
- Undertake general research and evaluation activities including literature searches, data collection, data entry and reporting
- Present data clearly and creatively for reporting purposes to lay audience
- Produce plain English reports, summarising results and findings

- Maintain research and evaluation records including organising data sets, ensuring secure data storage and version control
- Work within organisational requirements in line with all policies and procedures.

 credibility and respect amongst staff; demonstrate a high level of discretion and
 maintain strict confidentiality; demonstrate maturity and professionalism;

- Teamwork work collaboratively with the research and evaluation team to accomplish goals; seek to understand the varied work of other professionals within RANSW; understand and respond flexibly to challenges in collecting and analysing data in service delivery contexts; reinforce the RANSW values and vision.

- Confident in applying appropriate statistical techniques with survey data and outcomes data
