Carry out ongoing checks of accuracy of works (line, level, dimension, stabilisation depth etc.) for the duration of the stabilisation works. Liaise with and if required supervise water cart operations to ensure that adequate water supply is available on project sites to supply for the mixing operations. Read and interpret plans, specifications and designs as they relate to road construction and pavement stabilisation.
