POSITION SUMMARY

VACCA's playgroups are available to all children and families in our Community and provide a culturally safe place for vulnerable families to participate in activities with their children alongside strong Aboriginal Community members. They also provide a supportive place of mentoring and peer support. VACCA's playgroups focus on: intentional based learning and play; facilitating positive parent-child interactions and parental skill development; supporting child development and school readiness; developing cultural knowledge and identity of children and families; participation of Elders, Community members and artists to develop strong connections to culture and Community; providing information about services including maternal child health; and affirming Aboriginal childrearing practices

- Engaging and consulting with Aboriginal Elders regarding the cultural components of the program

- Supporting the transport needs of playgroup participants when necessary
- Liaising and consulting with the program Team Leader about any issues of concern regarding child development and program planning

- Participating in further training as considered appropriate.
