# **BACKGROUND**

The Victorian Aboriginal Child Care Agency (VACCA) is the largest organization of its kind in Australia. VACCA is an Aboriginal community-controlled organization that supports and advocates for the Aboriginal community. Our strength lies with our people. Our team is committed to the organisation's vision and values; advocates for our children and other vulnerable community members; and shows respect for, observance and compliance with Aboriginal cultural protocols, practice and ceremony. Our Aboriginality is what distinguishes us from mainstream services and what enables us to deliver the positive outcomes we achieve for our people.

VACCA employs over 600 staff and delivers more than 70 programs across the state. VACCA's experience and expertise in the delivery of therapeutic interventions are underpinned by culture, connection, and healing. VACCA designs, develops and delivers programs with self-determination and an understanding that the intergenerational trauma experienced by our community requires intergenerational and community healing.

Central to VACCA's work is the importance of connection to family, community and culture as essential to Aboriginal children's safety, stability and ensuring that they have an ongoing sense of belonging. As Victoria's largest Aboriginal child welfare agency, VACCA will play a key role in the process of transitioning the care and case management of Aboriginal children from government and non-Aboriginal organisations to Aboriginal community-controlled organisations following the recent decision of the Victorian Government.

The support will include an assessment and intake which identifies goals and has a plan developed to address these issues.

- An ability to work in a culturally respectful and competent manner with individuals, families, and communities to ensure that cultural connections are fostered and maintained.
- Understanding & knowledge of local services across a range of sectors including child welfare, health, employment, education, housing and legal.
- Ability to advocate on behalf of individuals and families.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to write reports, case notes and record keeping skills.
- Ability to work flexible hours occasionally.
- Computer skills.

# POSITION ACCOUNTABILITIES

- To support Aboriginal men in Gippsland by providing information, advice, and supported referrals to a range of mainstream and Aboriginal services.
- To provide phone, office, and outreach support to address issues, resolve conflict, and increase capacity to better manage and improve their safety and wellbeing.
- To advocate for individuals and assist them to overcome barriers to services.
- To develop and maintain relationships with stakeholders and providers to promote access and pathways to their services for Aboriginal people.
- To develop and maintain partnerships with VACCA services and local ACCO's.
- To actively promote and provide service and referral information to community service organisations and Aboriginal service providers and programs in the Gippsland region.
- Provide support to other VACCA workers and programs as required.
- Participate in ongoing professional development and training and supervision.
- Input data into the appropriate client database and be responsible for maintaining client information.
- Undertaking other duties as directed.
- Participate in training programs and in supervision.
